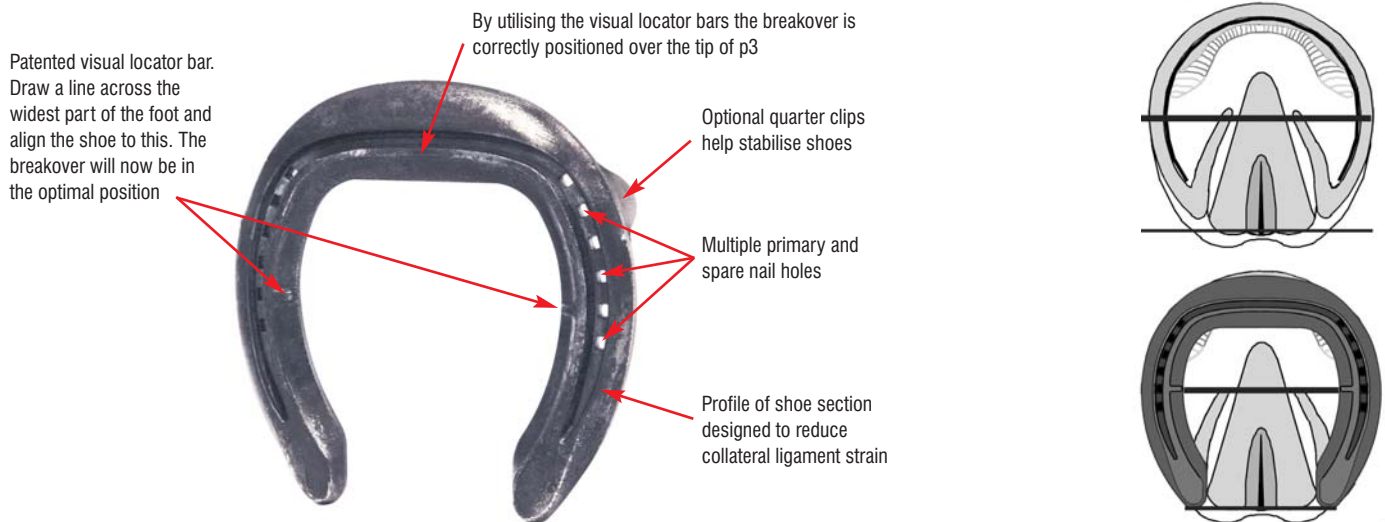

The design of this shoe compliments the latest information regarding equine foot function and biomechanics relating to excess leverages and balance around the distal interphalangeal joint.

- Patented visual locator bars eliminate guesswork when fitting
- Optimal results are obtained by following simple guidelines for foot trimming and placement (a copy of these instructions can be found in every box or by visiting www.centrefit.com)
- Shoe section allows for easier turning - reducing the risk of injury
- Lateral/medial relief making this the first multi directional shoe for both the sports and general use horse
- Unique design provides superb traction
- First "bespoke" hind shoe utilising early breakover
- Seated out to eliminate sole pressure
- Even nail hole placement - easy to nail even broken walls
- Strong and long clips for stability on the foot, even when using pads
- Fullered concave shoe utilising plain heels for punched or drilled stud holes
- Clean finish

The Centre Fit shoe has been designed to assist in the correct alignment of the distal limb/h hoof pastern axis and place the shoe evenly around the DIP/coffin joint. Trimming the heels with respect to the functional sole is critical to produce a good base of support and for achieving proper caudal foot function. At the same time, the toe is not over trimmed to ensure adequate sole thickness. Correct placement of the shoe with respect to the widest part of the foot, in tern places breakover in the optimal position for performance and long term soundness.
